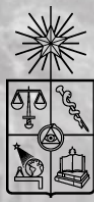

Application Requirements	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Personal statement (in Spanish or English, 500 words approx.). 2. Official transcript of records (signed by the home institution). 3. Copy of passport. 4. Digital photo (size 240x320 pixels, white and plain background, face frame only as passport photo coverage area, this document must be in ".jpg" format, min. 1MB). 5. Simple letter from the home institution certifying the student's level of Spanish (minimum B1). 	
Language Requirements	Given the need to verify that students have a sufficient level of Spanish to perform in academic fields, institutions of origin will need to certify, through a simple document, that the nominated students have at least level B1 in Spanish. This document will be mandatory and must be submitted by the students when completing the application process.	
Nominations	Partner universities should nominate students through the Nomination Form .	Spring semester (August– December 2026) Annual (August 2026 – July 2027) [Summer break January and February 2027]
Application	Application instructions and a link to registration will be sent directly to the nominated students, and they should complete the application through the Application Form .	Deadlines Nomination: April 30th 2025 Application: May 15th 2025
Academic Calendar	Autumn Semester 2026 will be announced beginning in March 2026 Spring Semester 2026 will be announced starting in August 2026.	
Academic Offer	Architecture	Exchange students can choose courses from the three degrees taught at FAU - University of Chile. The course catalogue is available and published just before each semester. It is necessary to review ONLY AS REFERENCE previous equivalent semesters.

Acceptance Letter	It will be sent to the accepted students gradually as they complete the application.		
Course Registration	<p>The course registration will occur the week before classes start through a form based on specific allocation criteria.</p> <p>Students should identify course options according to their academic priorities and needs.</p> <p>Students will be informed of the process promptly via email.</p>		
Visa	<p>Students must review the necessary information for applications for visas required to be in Chile and must complete the process in sufficient time for the visa to be granted:</p> <p>Visa de Residencia Temporal: This permit may be applied for by foreign persons interested in settling in Chile to study in educational establishments recognized by the State, meeting the corresponding requirements.</p> <p>Visa de Permanencia Transitoria: Permission granted to foreign persons entering the country for tourism, business, or other reasons, for a limited time, without intentions of residence or establishment. The permit entitles you to stay in the country for 90 days, which may be extended once by an additional 90 days.</p> <p>SERVICIO NACIONAL DE MIGRACIONES DE CHILE</p> <p>At the University of Chile, we have a specific agreement with the National Migration Service to streamline the process for students who come to the University of Chile. Information on how to proceed will be sent along with the Acceptance Letter to the students.</p>
